Another incredible week in school!

We have acted out the story of Dogger using talk for writing actions. This has then helped us to re-write the whole story independently. Children were incredible at recalling the story and adding in some of their own detail too!

In Maths, Year 2 have been looking at telling the time, ask us to show you! Year 1 have been thinking about half of things, such as half a biscuit, a half of pizza and what this means.

EYFS have been looking at subtraction this week and how to take away from a given number.

The children have been creating special buildings in RE looking at Mosques and Churches.

We have been thinking about creating shapes and patterns in computing and how these correlate together like a computer program. Children then took a selfie using the ipad to showcase their work.

We have been enjoying our outdoor provision more lately with it being sunny - Children have loved using the area and completing challenges within the provision.
