EYFS have been looking at subtraction this week and how to take away from a given number.

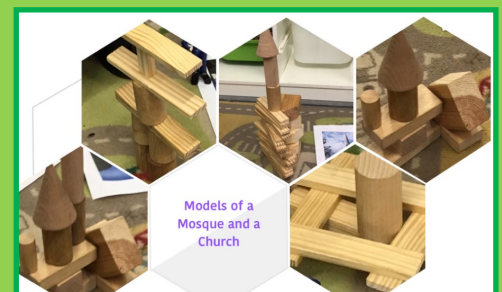
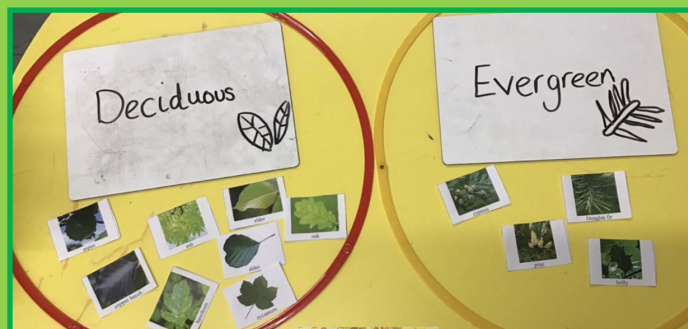
The children have been creating special buildings in RE looking at Mosques and Churches.

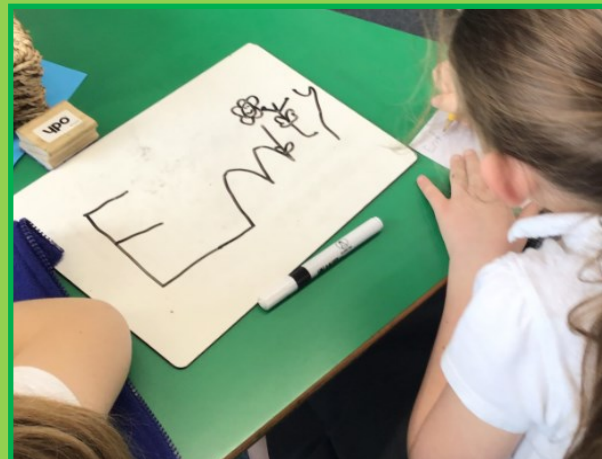

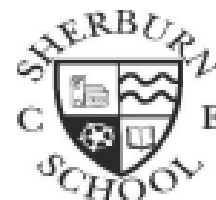
Finally a huge thank you to our Year 6's who have completed their SATs this week. We are incredibly proud of them.
