Our Learning This Week.....Class 2

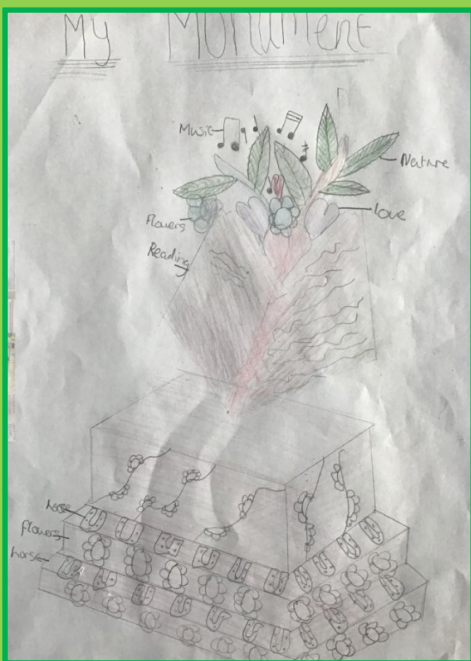
This week in DT we have finished our monument designs. The children had a great time designing their own monuments and were really successful in drawing in 3D.

In Science, we have been looking at the digestive systems as well as teeth. We have tested different types of toothbrushes and started to look at different animal teeth too.

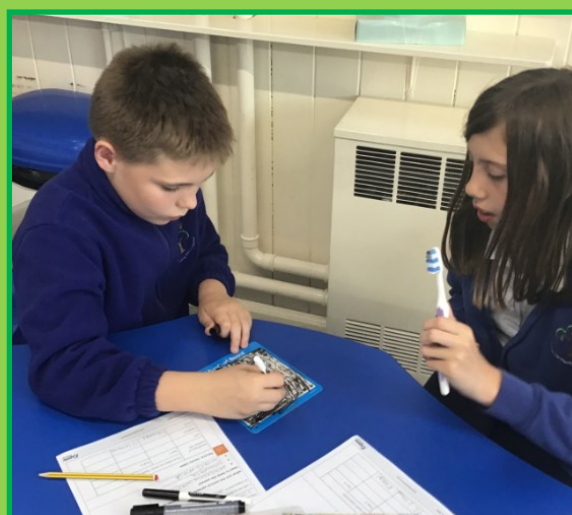
