In PSHE, we have designed our own healthy meals and have learnt about the different food groups.


In Maths, we have been measuring angles. We have used masking tape to measure different angles and have used angle chompers to find right angles in our environment.


Finally, we have started our topic on the Vikings and Can't wait to learn more about
