North Yorkshire Police has launched a competition for the county's young creatives to design a Christmas card with the chance to win a VIP police visit to their school.

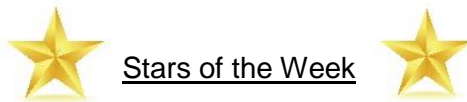
The competition is open to anyone aged 4 to 16 years old and the design needs to be festive-themed and feature a police officer, police dog or police vehicle – or all three!
