This week in class 1 we have been acting out different actions to practice words to describe the sea.

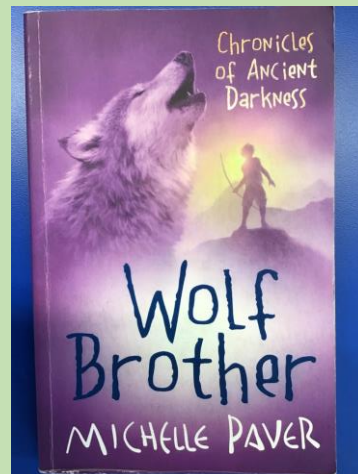
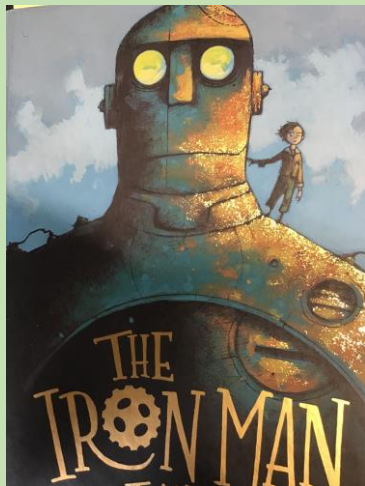


We have also been learning about patterns and making our own repeating patterns.

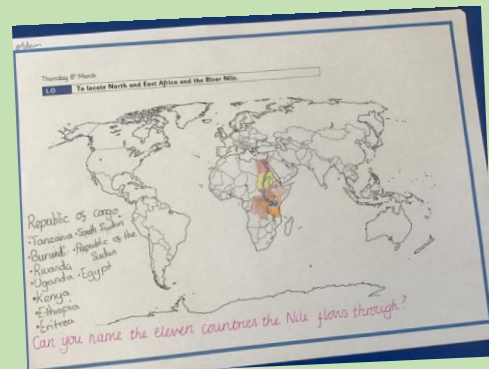
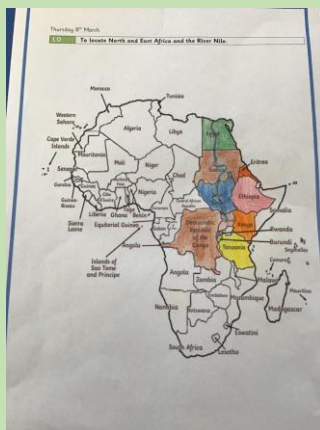


In Forest Schools we have been making birds nests.
